

Creative Quarantine:

DIY art relief from the Lincoln City Cultural Center

Foam Printing with Washable Marker

You will need: Clean Styrofoam “to go” container, washable markers, pencil, scissors and white paper (copy paper works well).

1. Cut out flat areas from the Styrofoam container. This is a great use for them instead of throwing them away.
 2. Draw your design into the foam with a not-too-sharp pencil. Press firmly into the foam to make reasonably deep marks. Remember each line or dot you scratch will come out white on your print.
 3. Color in your foam scratch drawing with washable markers. Layer the colors a bit for more interesting combinations and mixings of color.
 4. Then wet your paper in the sink and lay it carefully over your foam artwork. Press down gently and after a minute, peel it off to reveal your amazing print.
- *Remember prints come out as mirror images so any words or letters will be backwards on the print.
5. Wipe off your foam to color in and print again or do a whole new one on the back. Have Fun.
