# G-Men dump Benson in dual meet

Anything worth doing is worth doing well," is the first step to being a member of our track and field team. It seems the Generals have done just that by clipping Benson 77-59 at last Friday's meet.

Lester Parker, Brian Davis, Jim Gilbert, Doug Graham, members of the 440 relay team, knocked a second off the PIL time with 44.1. Jim Gilbert took the 100 yard dash with a time of 10.1. Lester Parker and

Doug Graham came in second and third; all three of them making personal bests and scoring nine points.

John Adamovics captured the 880 yard run with a time of 2:05.4; Jime Gilbert won the 220 dash with a time of 23.1. In this same event Lester Parker improved his personal time to 23.4.

In the two mile run, Mike Hann of Benson broke a PIL dual meet record with a time of 9:15.5. He also

cracked a record in the mile run with a time of 4:15; Scott Jackson bettered his personal record with a time of 4:20.8.

Bob Usselman, Steve Crane, Phil Horton and Brian Davis took the mile relay with a time of 3:33.2, which is their best time. In the shot put Ralph Bakkenon put the shot 55' 1/2"; he also captured the discus event with a toss of 157' 7". Greg Schukart bettered his distance with 142' 4". Barry Heidt was top man in the pole vault with a height of 13' 0", which is a school record.

The Varsity city track relay meet will be held at Madison at 4:00 today. The J.V. team participated in the city meet yesterday at Jackson.
