

Students learn to dye eggs

One of the most interesting aspects of Russian culture is the traditional dyeing of Easter eggs. However, these eggs are, more accurately, waxed. During the week of return to school, Russian classes have been learning this art.

The eggs are not hard boiled but are used raw. The dyeing process begins when a design is drawn onto the egg in pencil. The dyer decides what colors he wants the egg, and waxes those parts of the egg he does not want to be the first color. (Usually, the lighter colors are used first; darker colors are used last.) The waxed egg is then dipped into the dye.

After the first dipping, the

wax is either melted or scraped off, and re-applied for placement of the second color. The process is continued until the whole egg is dyed. After its completion, the egg may be shellacked or polished.

During the week seven people

managed to break eight eggs. The fourth year class was able to claim responsibility for the most broken "ya-eet-sew" or eggs.

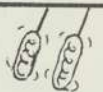
In Russia, these eggs often sell for around \$4.00. The dyeing of one egg usually takes about two hours.
