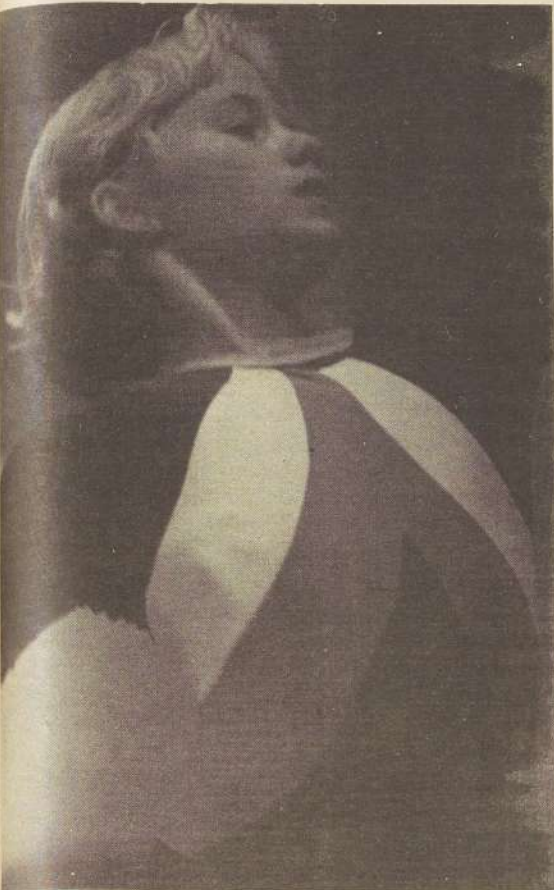

Like women's volleyball Coach Loren Swivel, first-year women's cross country Coach Marilyn Lensenmeyer is running into a participation problem. Lensenmeyer currently has only one member on her 1979 team, and it takes at least five to field a team.

Even though Nancy Reynolds is the sole member of the team, it does not appear that it hinders her success as a runner. She captured the Pier Point Invitational last Saturday. Reynolds, a freshman out of Illinois Valley High School near Medford, finished first in a field of 22 in her initial race of the year.
