

All-Americans honor College

Beth Kokesh, Mo Kelley, Nancy Reynolds, Peg Winczewski and Jackie Beaudry represented the College's women's cross country team to earn the distinction of having the fifth highest cumulative GPA for a women's cross country team in 1980 to be named Academic All-Americans.

The individual GPAs for the five Cougars were: Kokesh, 3.5; Kelley, 3.25; Reynolds, 3.1; Winczewski, 3.06; and Beaudry, 2.88. The GPAs were from Fall term 1980 only.

The combined Cougar GPA averaged to 3.24. The four colleges with higher GPAs than the College were Garden City, 3.61; Lane, 3.60; McComb,

3.42; and Dodge City, 3.35. Other colleges on the list were Farmington, 3.22; Barton 3.16; Rochester, 2.96, and Gloucester, 2.84.

The kayaking class is for beginners who will be charged \$40 for equipment rental in addition to tuition.

The College conditioning course will take on a new look this summer with two-hour sessions, and class content including aerobics, weight training, jogging and possible bicycling depending on whether students have bicycles at their disposal.
