'Schizoid Plus' reaches out with creative show

The Clackamas Community College improvisational group, "Schizoid Plus," is planning a special children's show that will go on tour at the end of winter term.

According to Roby Robinson, director of the improvisational group, the show is still in its "embryonic stages" but will run approximately 20 minutes with lots of audience participation and comedy.

"The improvisational group is an adept group of people who are really receptive and responsive to other characters and the audience. This creates a creative atmosphere," said Robinson.

The show will play to children throughout Clackamas County in day care centers, hospitals, parks and schools. In the past, Schizoid Plus has concentrated on nursing homes, senior citizens centers and others

who would not have a chance to see performances of this sort.

This concentration on senior citizens had a beneficial effect on all those involved. The members of the group get a chance to meet the older generation and the older people get a chance to know young people. Both groups found themselves rejecting preconceptions.

"When we were told we'd be doing a show for old people, I was nervous," said a group member. "I had visions of them being old, rotten and nasty, but they aren't."

The new children's show should provide an opportunity for still two generations to get acquainted.

"I know for a fact that it will be a show and very entertaining," said Roby Robinson.

Renowned guitarist appears in recital

Christopher Parkening, guitarist extraordinaire, will appear in recital on stage at the Portland Civic Auditorium on Tuesday, Feb. 7, at 8:15 p.m. The noted young artist will appear here under the aegis of Celebrity Attractions.

Blond, California-born Parkening is the first American ever to achieve the position of world-renowned virtuoso of the guitar. In every center of musical learning throughout the world, he is recognized as one of the few superb masters of the classical guitar.

Not only lauded for his recital appearances, Parkening is in great demand as a guest artist with such major orchestras as the New York Philharmonic, the Philadelphia Orchestra, the Boston Symphony, the Los Angeles Philharmonic, San Francisco Symphony, Washington National Symphony, the orchestras of Baltimore, Dallas, and Houston. In addition to these activities, he is fulltime instructor and Head of the Guitar Department of the University of Southern California and of the Southern California School of Music.
