

Women hoopsters downed twice

The CCC Women roundballers suffered two losses last week as they came up against two of their toughest competitors.

Last Tuesday the Cougar gals went up against Lane CC and were downed 59-40. That was the seventh straight win for this year's undefeated squad.

The Cougars managed only 37 attempts at the basket and were successful on 11 of them. (.297) Their opponents shot 26 for 60 from the field. (.433)

The Cougars were home again Thursday and were edged out of a win 40-39 against Clark College.

Although CCC led at halftime 24-21, a strong Clark press and several timely Clackamas turnovers kept the Cougars from maintaining their lead and the Cougars only basketed four field goals out of 23 attempts during the second half.

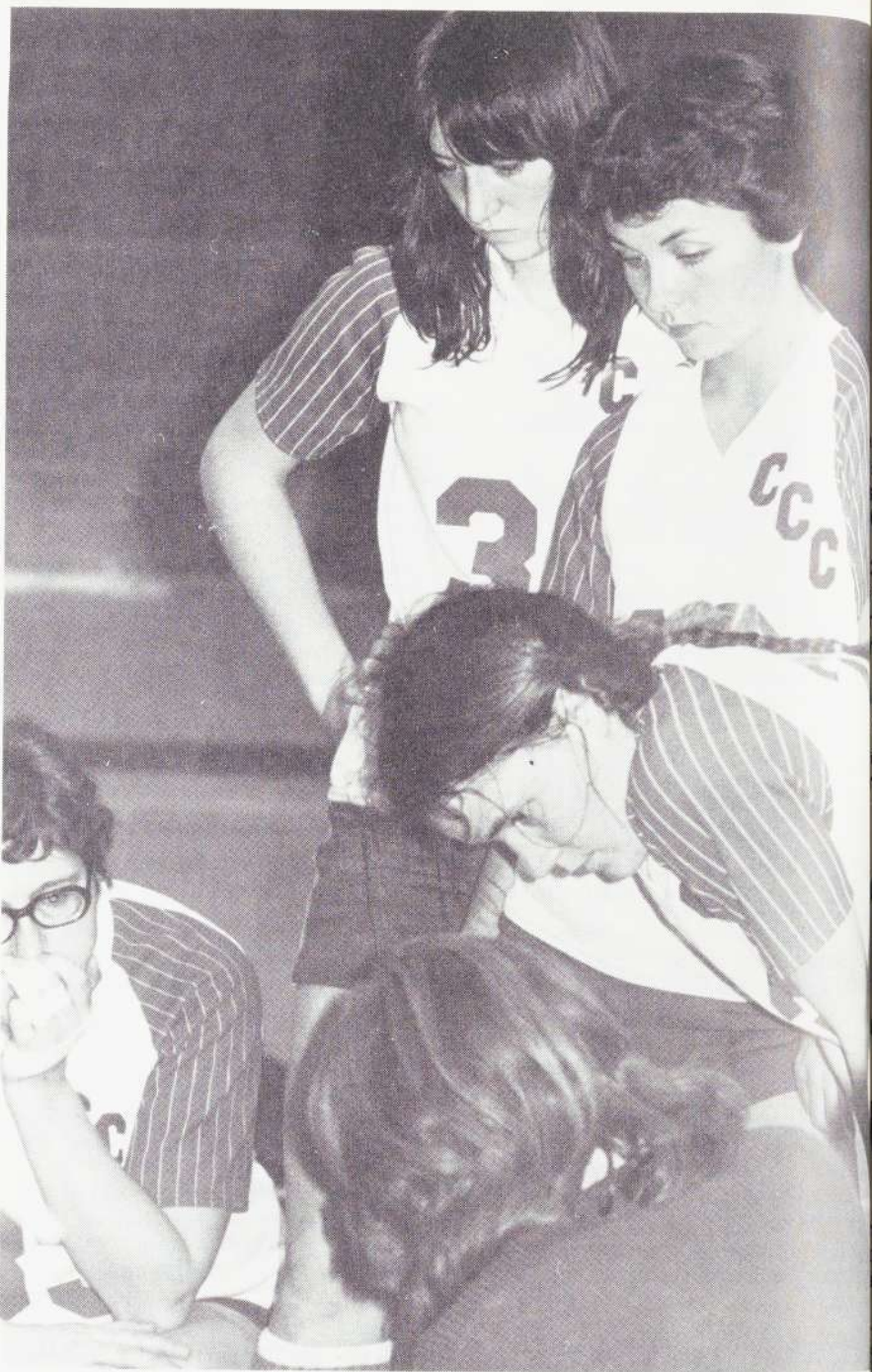
In the event, Clark College outrebounded Clackamas 45-26 and although they shot 15 for 59 from the field, (.254), the Cougars topped them in percentage with 19 out of 51 attempts (.313).

The losses dropped the CCC women to 0-2 for league play.
