Cooperative Work Experience (Secretarial Department) is a new class that will be offered this spring at Clackamas Community College.

"This class is designed to provide students with an opportunity to apply and integrate a whole range of business skills in a simulated office environment," said Jan Stennick, a Business Education instructor at CCC.

This class will be required next year before one can enroll in General Clerical or the Secretarial Science certificate program. "But it's also a good program for those who wish to brush up before returning to work," said Stennick

The only prerequisite for the class is to be able to type at least 35 words per minute. The spring term class requires four hours in class and ten hours of on-the-job training in various offices throughout the community per week, but is worth six credit hours. Starting fall term just four hours of classroom work will be required, but it will only be worth three credit hours.

The class will help students with work organization, office routines, human relations, business etiquette, oral, written and telephone communication, production ty-


