

# Applications for staff grants available

Grant applications are now available for Clackamas Community College staff members interested in the Women's Educational Equity Act program (WEEA) and readerships for the National Science Foundation (NSF), according to Joe Uris, CCC grants and special projects officer.

Pre-applications for the WEEA program must be in by April 29. Small grants are due by June 23, and general applications by June 30. Interested persons should contact Bernice Evans at ext. 266 or Uris at ext. 347.

By applying for a NSF readership a staff member will place his name on a list of those who desire to read proposals for the foundation. These proposals range from mathematics and computer science to history and philosophy. Proposals also deal with ethics and values in science and technology. Readers receive expenses and sometimes travel opportunities.

A committee consisting of Annette Sax, John Orrelle, Marv Thornley, Bob Ellis, Pat Krumm, Loretta Matulich and Uris has been formed to give awards to any staff member who has designed a proposal for CCC.

The proposal must be innovative, useful, fundable, and practical, said Uris.

The award would give staff members up to \$250 per individual to carry out their proposals.

All suggested nominees, and a three-page or less prospectus of their proposal, should be submitted by May 9 to Uris or any committee member. If a prospectus is unavailable, a complete proposal may be sent instead.
