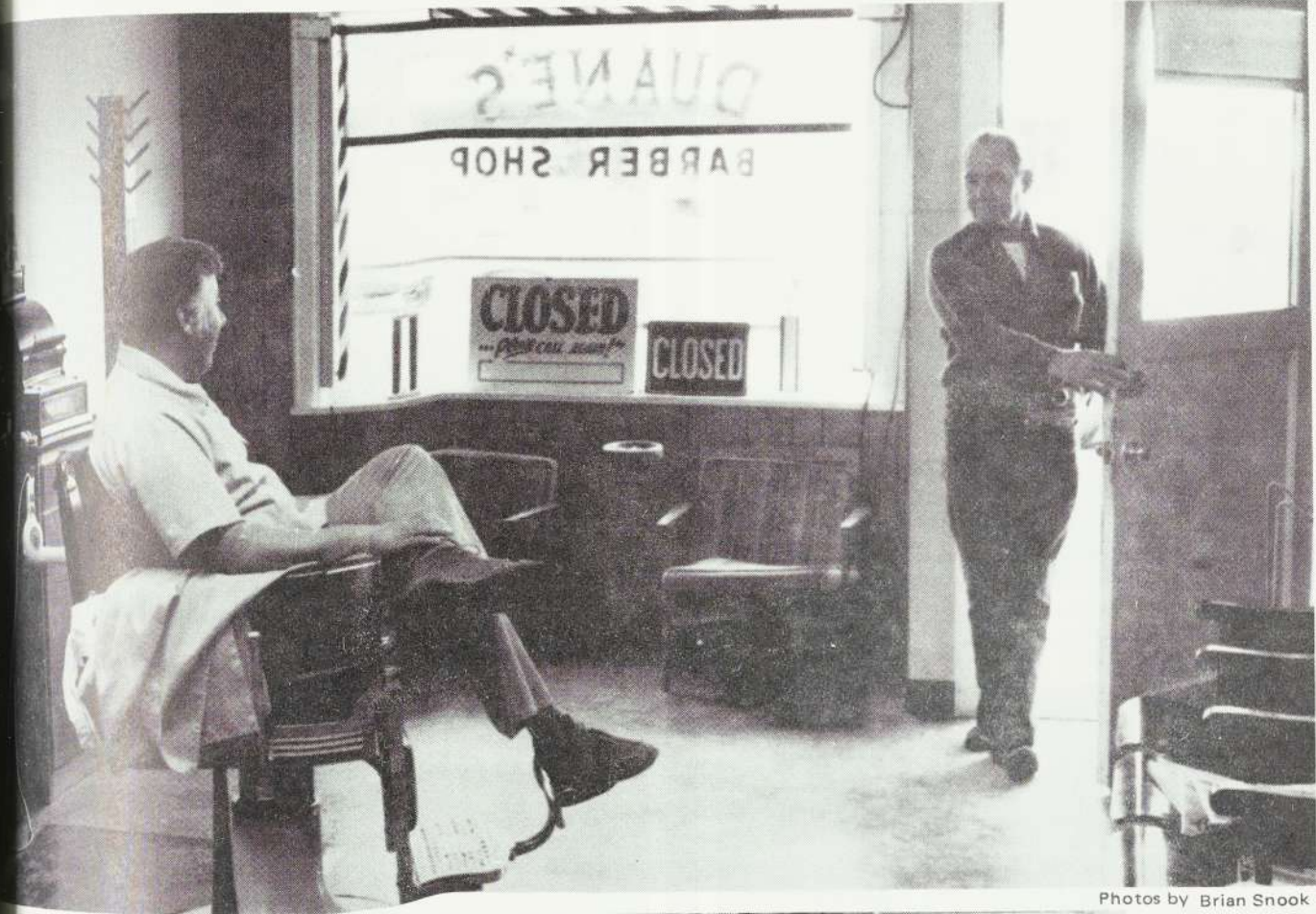
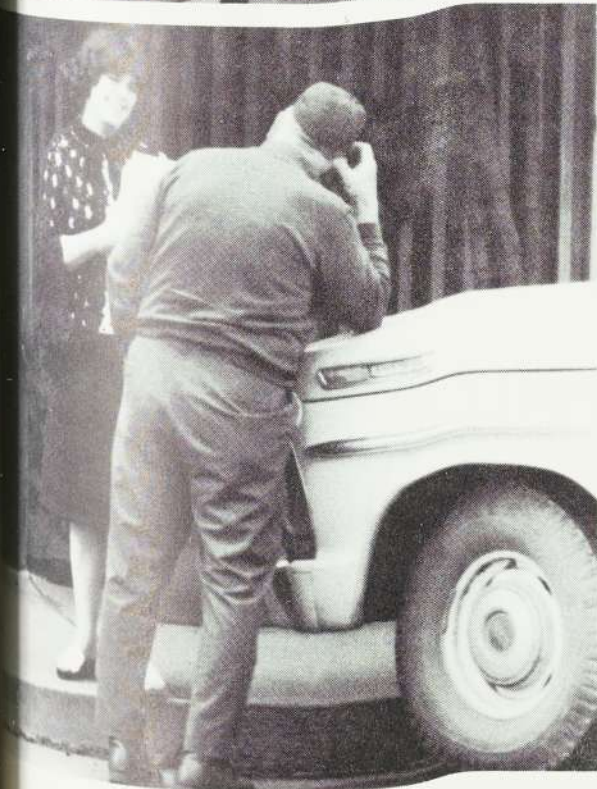


Log town people thrive
