

Cougars sweep South Puget, next stop NWAACC tournament

Preparations are in high gear for the women's softball team going into the NWAACC Championship Tournament in Spokane on May 25 and 26.

The Cougars finished off the season by sweeping their last double headers against South Puget Sound Community College to finish second in the Southern Division with a 13-7 record.

The first game saw Heather McCorkle pitch a five hitter with no walks as the Cougars shut out SPSCC 6-0.

The offense carried a lot of consistency as both Kristi Northcutt and Lisa Williamson went 2-3. Out of her four appearances at the plate Julie Troutner picked up three hits. Molly Bremmer also had a strong day going 2-4.

The Cougars picked up a total of 12 base hits against a pitcher that Coach Paul Fiskum feels will get votes as MVP of the league.

In the second game the bats were quieter but behind Linda Gross' one hit shutout they didn't need any for a 2-0 victory.

Defensively everything came together for the last game. "Everything we tried defensively worked. K.C. Jones picked two off first. Williamson robbed two base hits from them. Every-

one who tried to steal we got," explained Fiskum.

Clackamas' first match up in the tournament will be a rematch with Skagit Valley who the Cougars defeated in the Championship match. Earlier this season in a crossover tournament Clackamas lost to them in nine innings 4-6.

"They are one of the hottest teams in the Northwest. They started the season at 5-7 then shot out to a 12-8 by winning seven out of the next eight in route to a final 14-10 record. We didn't get a easy draw, but if we play as well defensively as we did on Wednesday, we will be okay," stated Fiskum.
