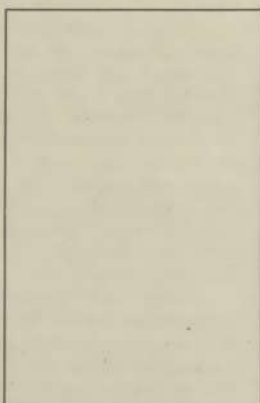
"I need a place to relax, a place to go. It doesn't matter where it is as long as there is a place."
