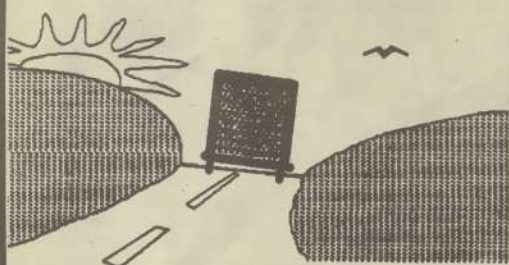
Athletic Idol: Roger Clemens, of Boston. "He's the best."
