Dave: Carol! Those ultimate symbols of freedom. Ya know, get your motor runnin' and head out on the highway.

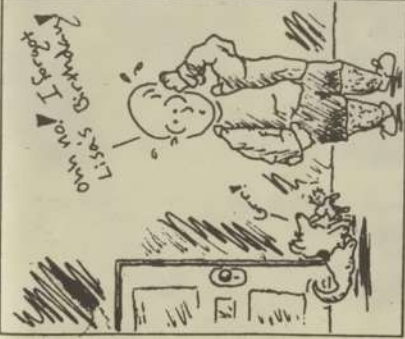
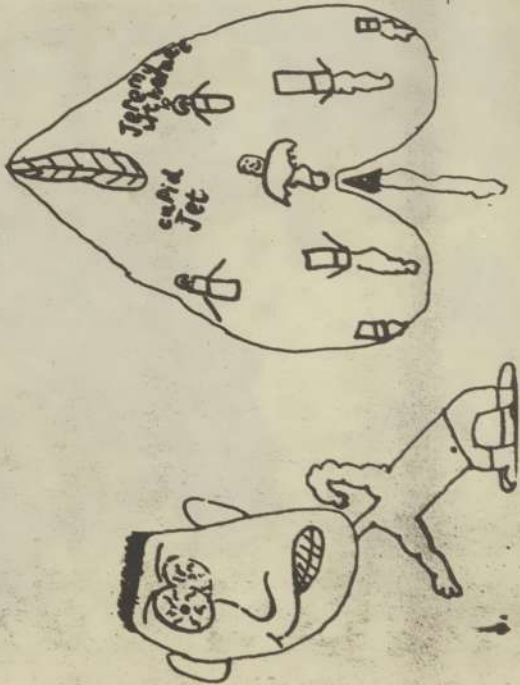
Not: Actually we're going to talk about how to take care of car problems cheaply.

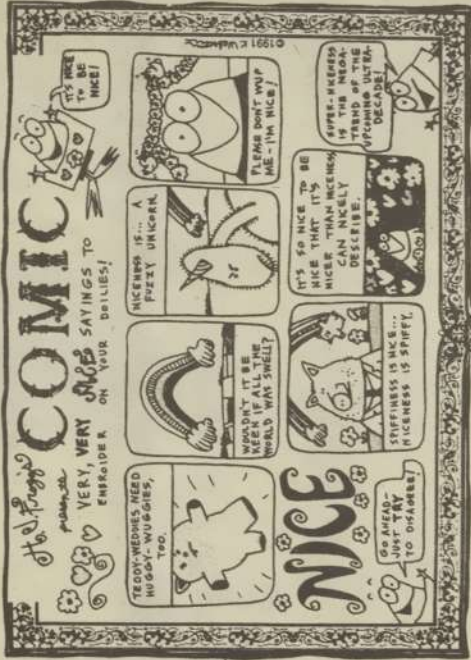

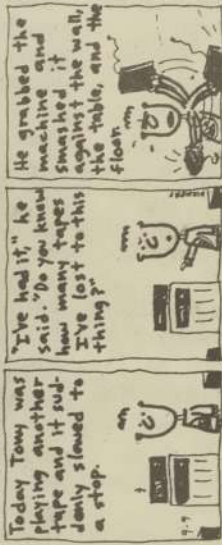

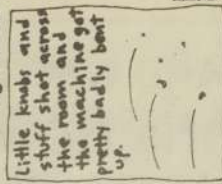
