Nole: Best soft serve ice cream around!

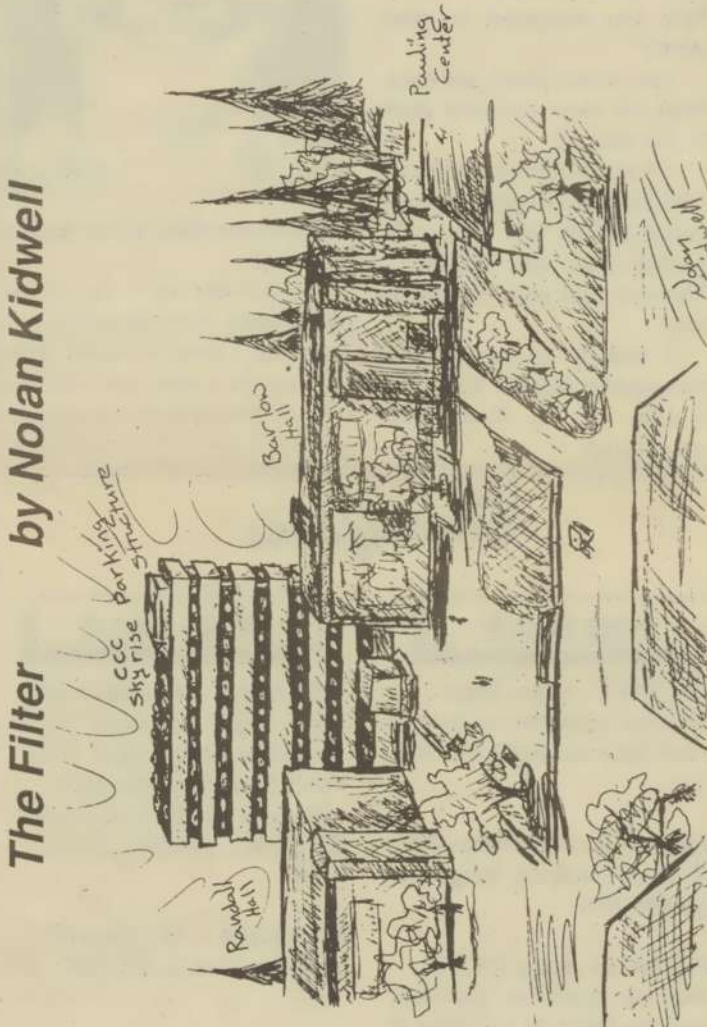
Dairy Queen (OC)*

Mr. Peterson was sleeping on the floor in a spot where the sun was shining through.

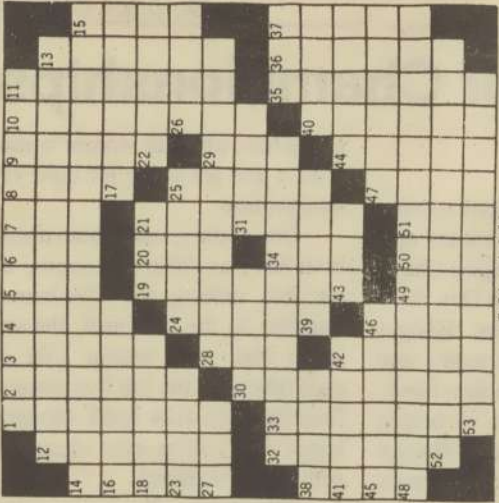

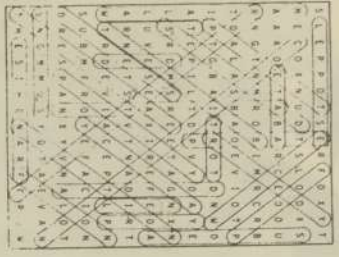
