SOAR is closing down. Gone will be the outdoor programs adapted for people with disabilities. The rafting, kayaking, camping, hiking, birding, skiing, rock climbing, horseback riding, bicycling and sailing with warm company and adaptive equipment may be lost.

Shared Outdoor Activities and Recreation was run by a small group of dedicated volunteers for the last 12 years. There were three paid staff members, a board of directors and hundreds of volunteers who gave their time and energy to make SOAR a success.

Unfortunately, those who were most instrumental in fighting the financial battles are tired of struggling year to year. The funding has mostly come from donations from large corporations which donate to non-profit corporations with the interest from their larger accounts. Low interest rates over the past years have limited the amount corporations can contribute to non-profits, causing further limitations on limited budgets.

SOAR's only hope is for someone to donate \$60,000. If that happens, a new corps of experienced people to help reorganize will also be needed.

I would like to help them restart and get people interested, so that people can benefit from the programs. Not only people with disabilities benefitted from SOAR's activities; so did the volunteers and the board members who have been involved in this group for whatever reason. To have SOAR shut down would be like telling students that there would be no more after school sports!

"Turn it down....turn down that 80's sh*t," says the whining man, while Gila Copters buzz their tired wings behind his poetic chatter. Nothing is turned

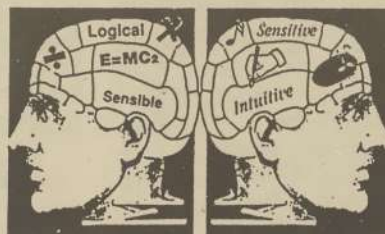
down. Everything is turned up and around while Jorgenson and Paul Barker, create their tunes and little brother looks on.
