Forget *Twister*; *Mission: Impossible* is the new blockbuster movie in America.

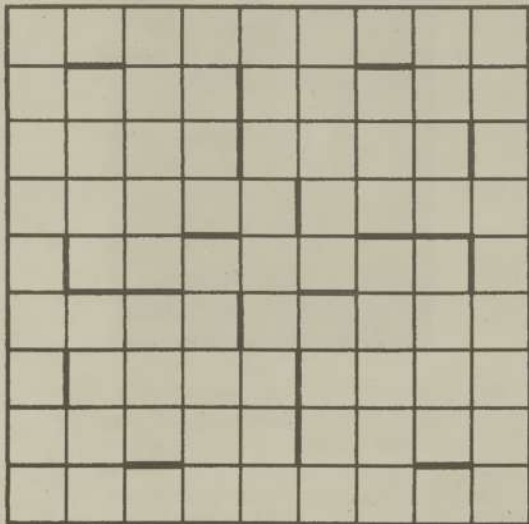
