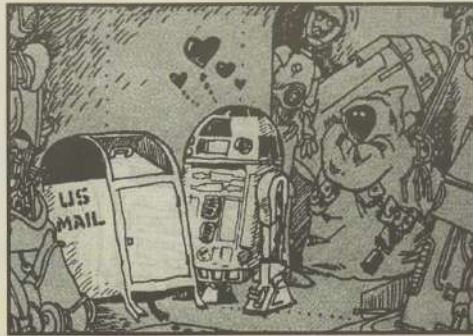


KUFO's Hummer visited Clackamas last Thursday for the annual skills contest.
