



Roadside memorials grace Oregon's Hwy. 213

Rivulets of rainwater fall from the petals of the pink rosebud cradled in the crook of the tiny, white cross.

The date is June 3, 1997, just two days after the hit-and run accident killed best friends Tracy Thompson and Triffina DeAngelo of Canby.

A few feet away, another white cross sits surrounded by tokens of affection from loved ones and strangers. A line from the poem encased in plastic and attached to the cross reads, "A child sits in silence, her laughter gone and her dreams unfulfilled. While a neighborhood realizes and a family mourns, a child is lost."

The tragedy has left family, friends

and local authorities frustrated. There were few clues left at the scene, located less than two miles south of Clackamas Community College on Highway 213 near Leland Road. Police are hoping the public will assist them by reporting any vehicle which may have suspicious front-end damage.

According to police reports, tire tracks ran some 100 feet in the ditch and no skid marks were noted on the pavement. As far as crime-scene experts could determine, the driver of the vehicle probably did not try to stop. They believe the driver was either under the influence of intoxicants or fell asleep at the wheel.

The girls, who lived near the accident site, were walking home following a party celebrating their graduation from Ackerman Middle School in Canby.

The Clackamas County Sheriff's department initiated a reward fund which has grown to over \$10,000.

Family friends have established an account at the Bank of America to assist in the girls' funeral expenses. Donations for the funeral expenses can be deposited at any Bank of America branch. 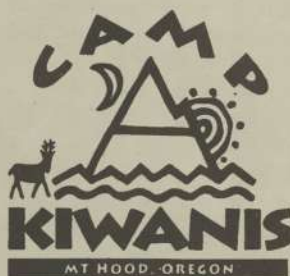
