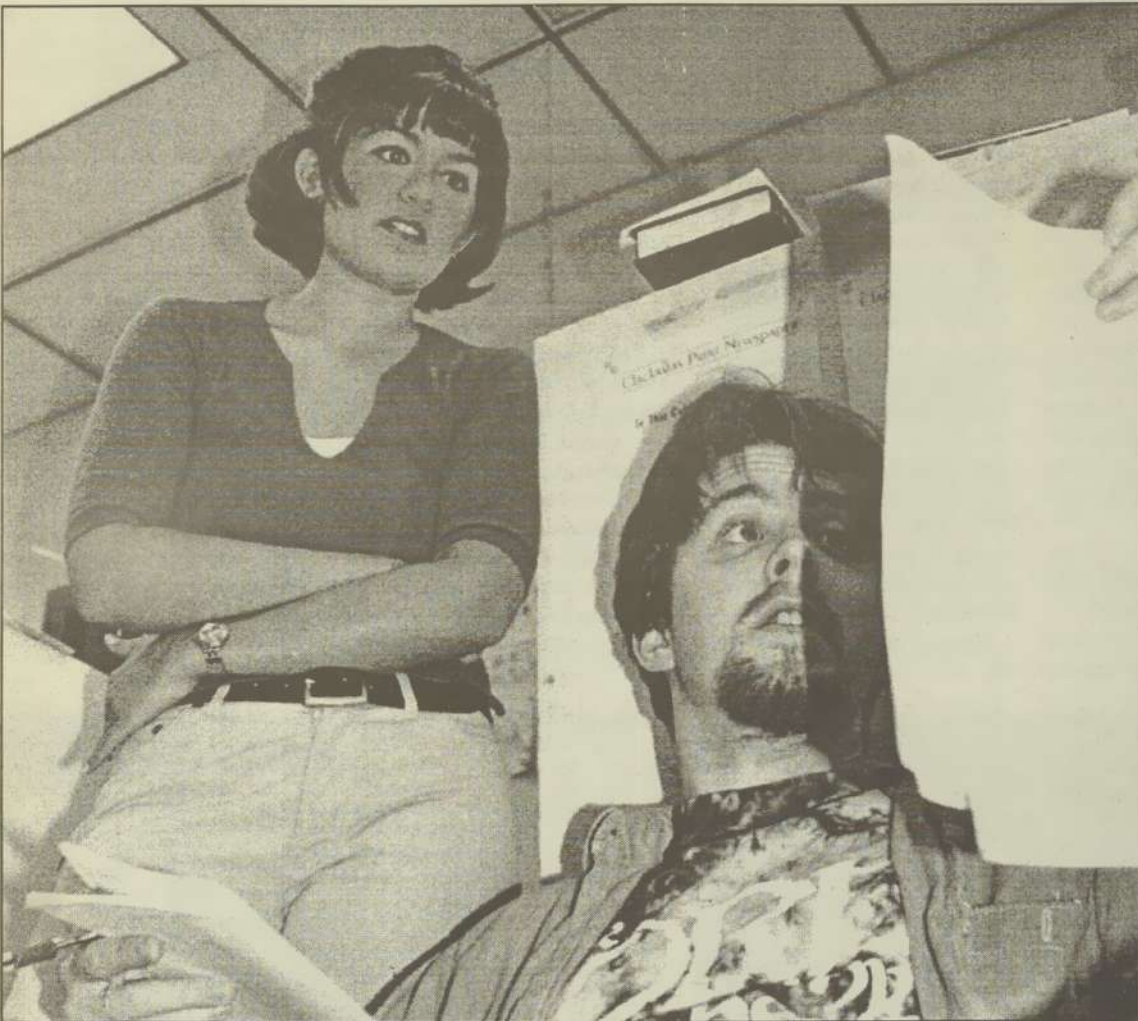

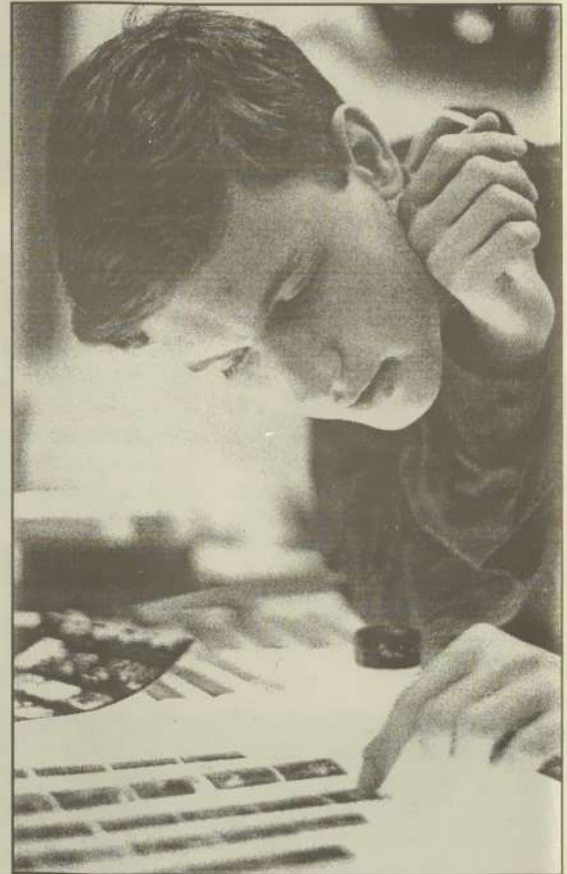

Cartoonist Joel "Israel" Gunderson contributes original art to the Clackamas Print each week. Gunderson has also been given a position this term as an Associate News Editor.



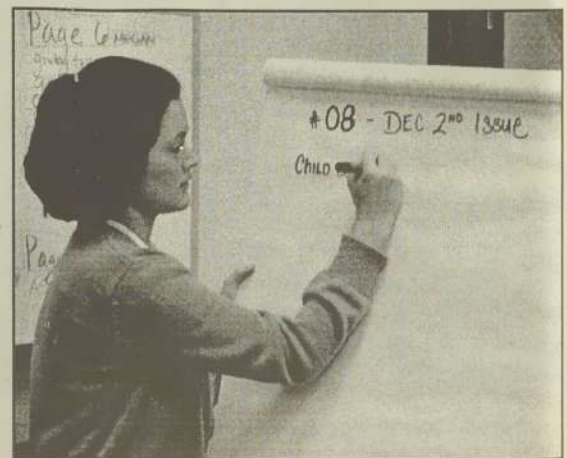
