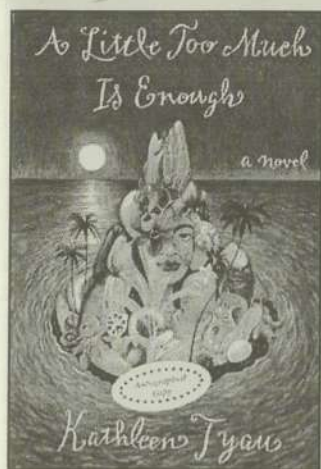

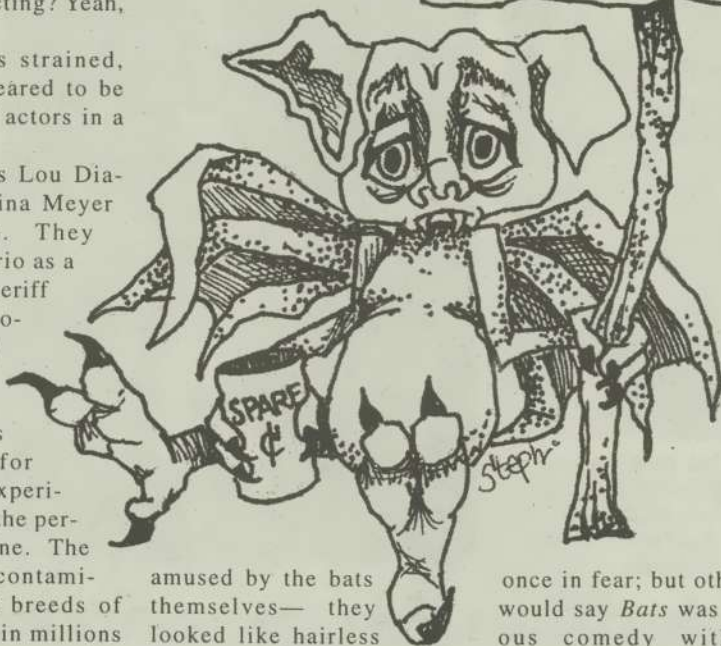
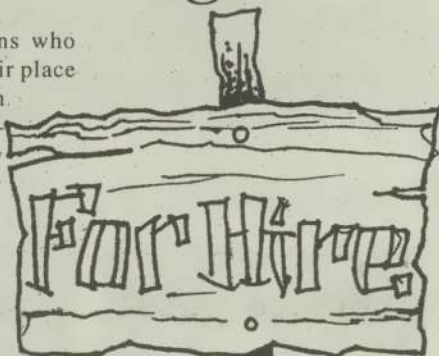

If you are looking for a good laugh, by all means it's worth the \$4.25 admission price.

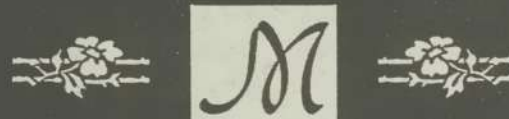
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
