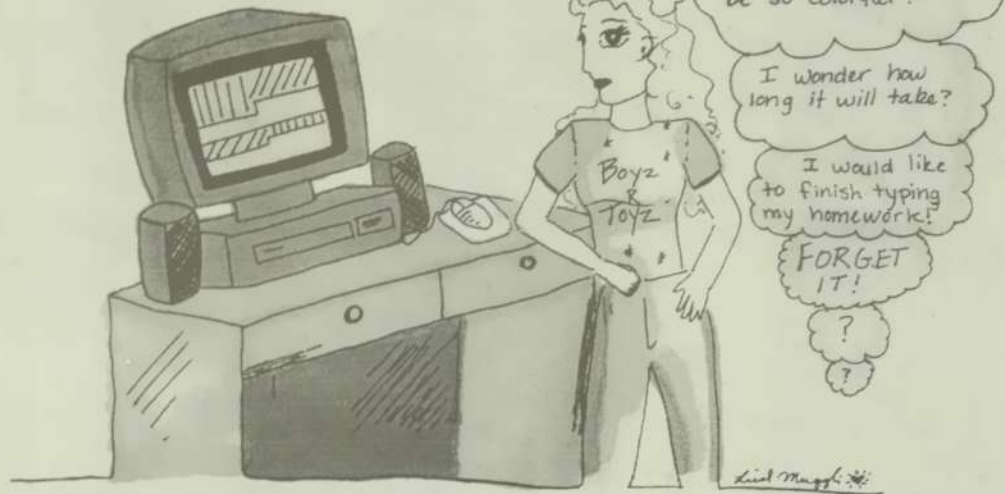

**Sagittarius:** Make use of your creativeness this week. Be prepared to get out and meet new people. Your magic word of the week: Activity.

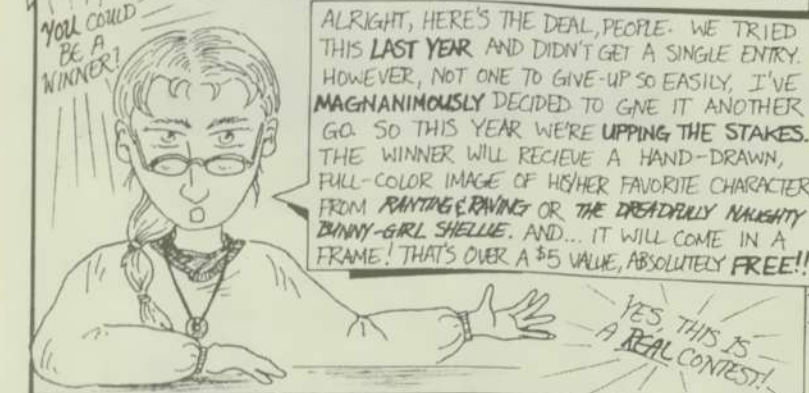
