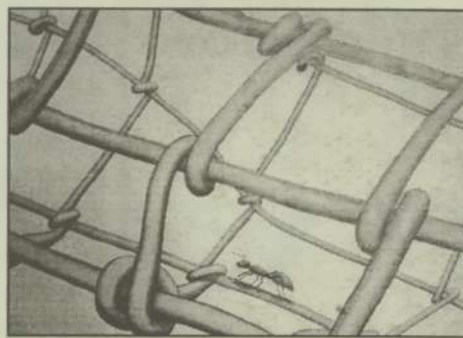

A KNIGHT ROCKS THE MIDDLE AGES

A *Knight's Tale*, a movie inspired by Geoffrey Chaucer's *Canterbury Tales*, is coming to Oregon theatres May 11, projecting a new spin on the Middle Ages in an amusing way.

The movie is a medieval romantic-adventure with an added touch of humor. Heath Ledger portrays a young squire, William Thatcher, who works his way up the jousting circuit after taking on a fake identity. As Ulrich Von Lichtenstein, William sets out to achieve his lifelong dream of being a knight, or as his father

says, "to change his stars."

While winning numerous jousting and swordplay competitions held across Europe, William excels at jousting and defeats many knights. With his two pals, Roland and Wat, who accompany him on this journey as varlets, William manages to keep his true identity a secret from the aristocracy he is rubbing shoulders with. Joining William and his friends is a crazy, gambling-ad-



dicted scribe named Geoffrey Chaucer.

Competing in numerable events, William catches the eye of the beautiful princess Jocelyn and becomes the rival of the snide Count Adhemar on both the field and as a pursuer of Jocelyn's affection.

A *Knight's Tale*, a Columbia Pictures production, was filmed in the Czech Republic and directed and screen written by Brian Helgeland whose previous movies have mostly been thrillers or crime stories. Starring are

Heath Ledger (William), Mark Addy (Roland), Paul Bettany (Geoffrey Chaucer), Rufus Sewell (Count Adhemar), Shannyn Sossamon (Jocelyn) and Alan Tudyk (Wat).

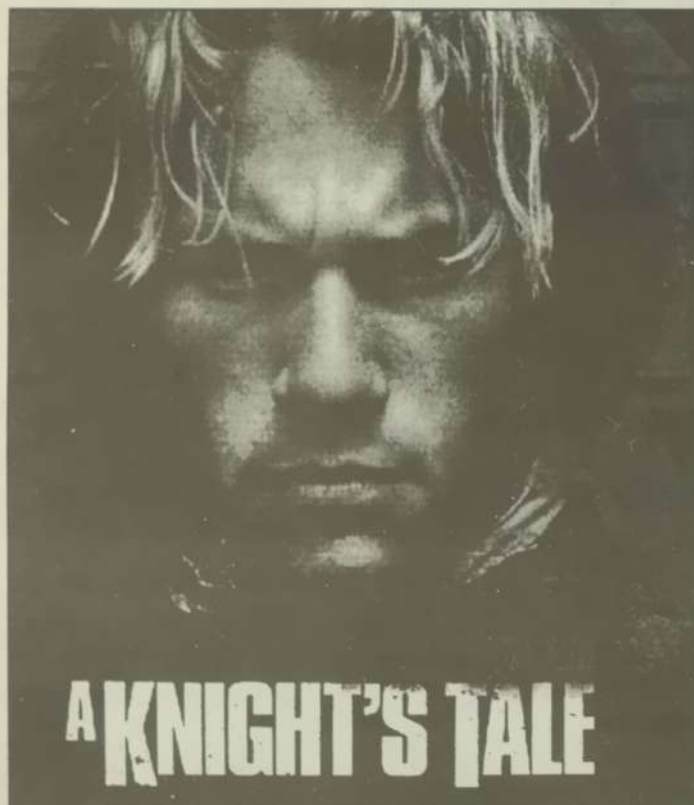
By incorporating 1970's music in his medieval story, Helgeland gives the movie a funny touch. You get to hear Bachman Turner Overdrive and Queen as well as KC and the Sunshine Band in a story that is set in the 1370's. A particular scene shows William attending a feast at a castle when, while dancing with Jocelyn, the medieval music and dancing transforms into disco and everybody starts to boogie.

Another funny component of

the story is the character of Geoffrey Chaucer, who is known as one of the most famous writers in history. Helgeland implies that it is Chaucer's journeys with William that later inspired him to write *The Canterbury Tales*.

Helgeland did a good job incorporating historic figures in the movie including Edward The Black Prince of Wales who has a few brief scenes in the movie.

A Knight's Tale is an amusing movie and will most likely make you laugh if you don't mind a literature piece turned into a joke. Although the movie is rated PG-13, it does contain some nudity as well as sex-related dialogue.
