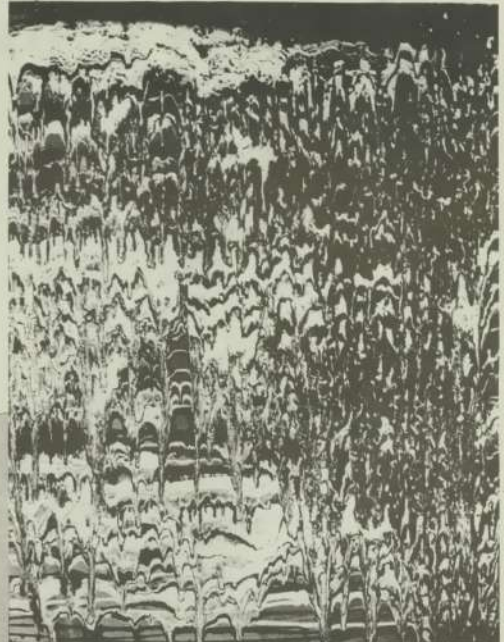


# Acrylic
