Taste of Spain visits CCC



The Hispanic theatre company Teatro Milagro will visit the campus to perform "Frida: un Retablo" Feb. 6. This free performance tells the story of the life of Frida Kahlo, a prominent 20th-century Mexican artist.

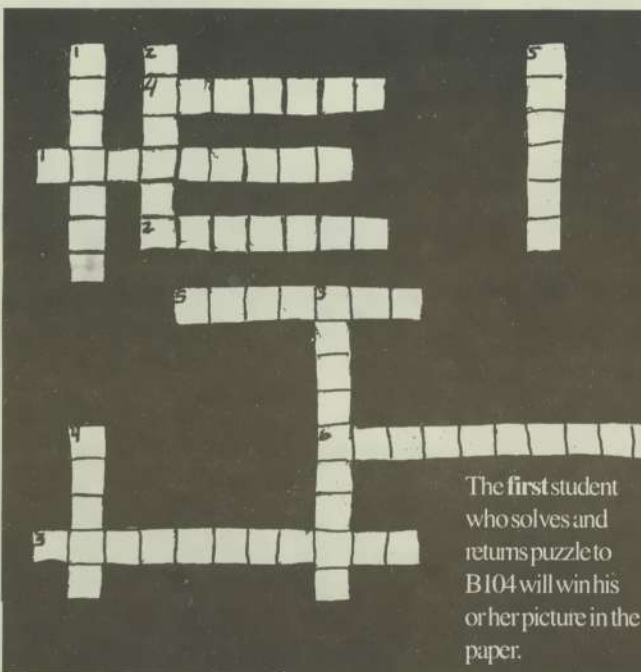
The profile of Kahlo is part of the company's "Season of Hope." Her revolutionary Expressionist style is famous for her more than 20 self-portraits, which portray deeply personal and not necessarily pleasant emotions. She addresses issues such as abandonment by her mother, acceptance of her unbeautiful body, with her faltering hair and polio-crippled legs, and her physical and psychological suffering in her life. Spanish instructor Irma Cristina Bjerre, who helped bring the play to the col-

lege, says she enjoys Kahlo's work not because it's easy, but because she expressed her emotions so effectively.

Bjerre says the company typically performs its plays, which have a Latino focus, in English with Spanish words thrown in for accent. This makes the productions both accessible and authentic, she says.

Teatro Milagro and the two sister companies in the group form the largest Hispanic theatre association in the Northwest. Teatro Milagro, which comprises the traveling third of the group, performs in Oregon, Washington, California and Idaho regularly.
