Mt. Hood CC has a new coach and their number one pitcher back from a year ago, but many other questions remain about the rest of the conference.

"All of the schools that are usually in the mix come tournament time like Edmonds CC, Spokane CC and South Puget Sound CC will more than likely be there again this year," commented Fiskum. "But you never know who will come out of the fold. Green River College was one of the worst teams in the NWAACC for five years running, but have been in the tournament the last two years, so you never know who will surprise."

The recent passing of assistant coach and program co-founder Bob Rapp has been and

will continue to be felt by the entire team and coaching staff.

"We certainly will miss Bob Rapp and his influence on our team. We are going to be wearing a patch on our uniforms honoring Bob and all he has done for the program, and softball in general," Fiskum said. "Brooke Comstock's dad, Ron, who is a top ASA coach in his own right, offered to help out with the program this season. His expertise will have a huge impact, and we are very glad to have him."

Clackamas opens the 2003 season with a trip to California during spring break to play in the Fresno City College tournament March 22-23. The Cougars return home to open regular season action on March 28, hosting Chemeketa CC in a doubleheader at 2 p.m.
