The story centers on a storm that brings togeth-

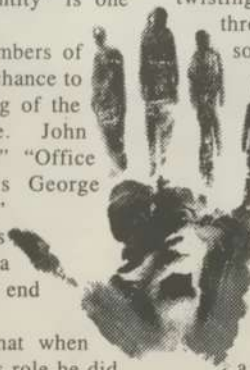

The deal with the pizza is that you

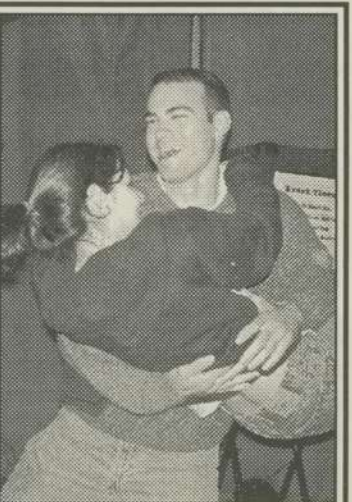

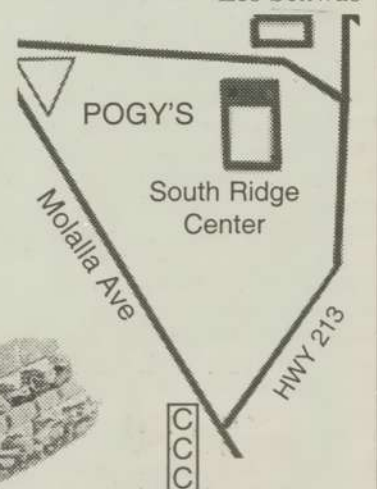
