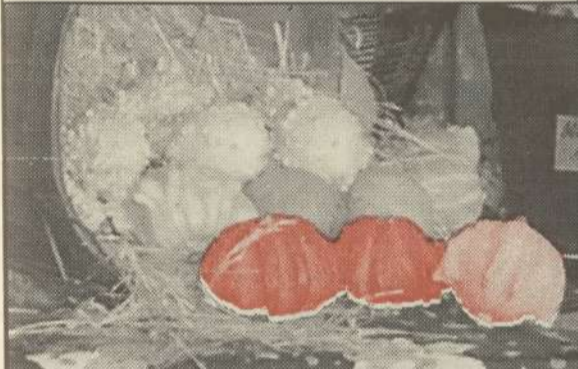
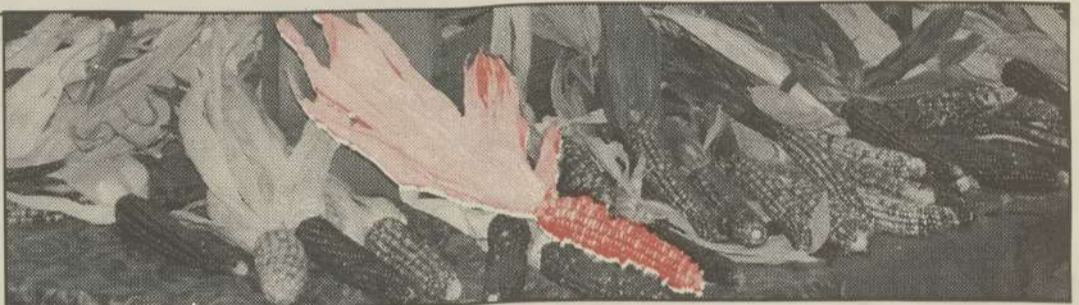

Taking a grave look at a local hearse club

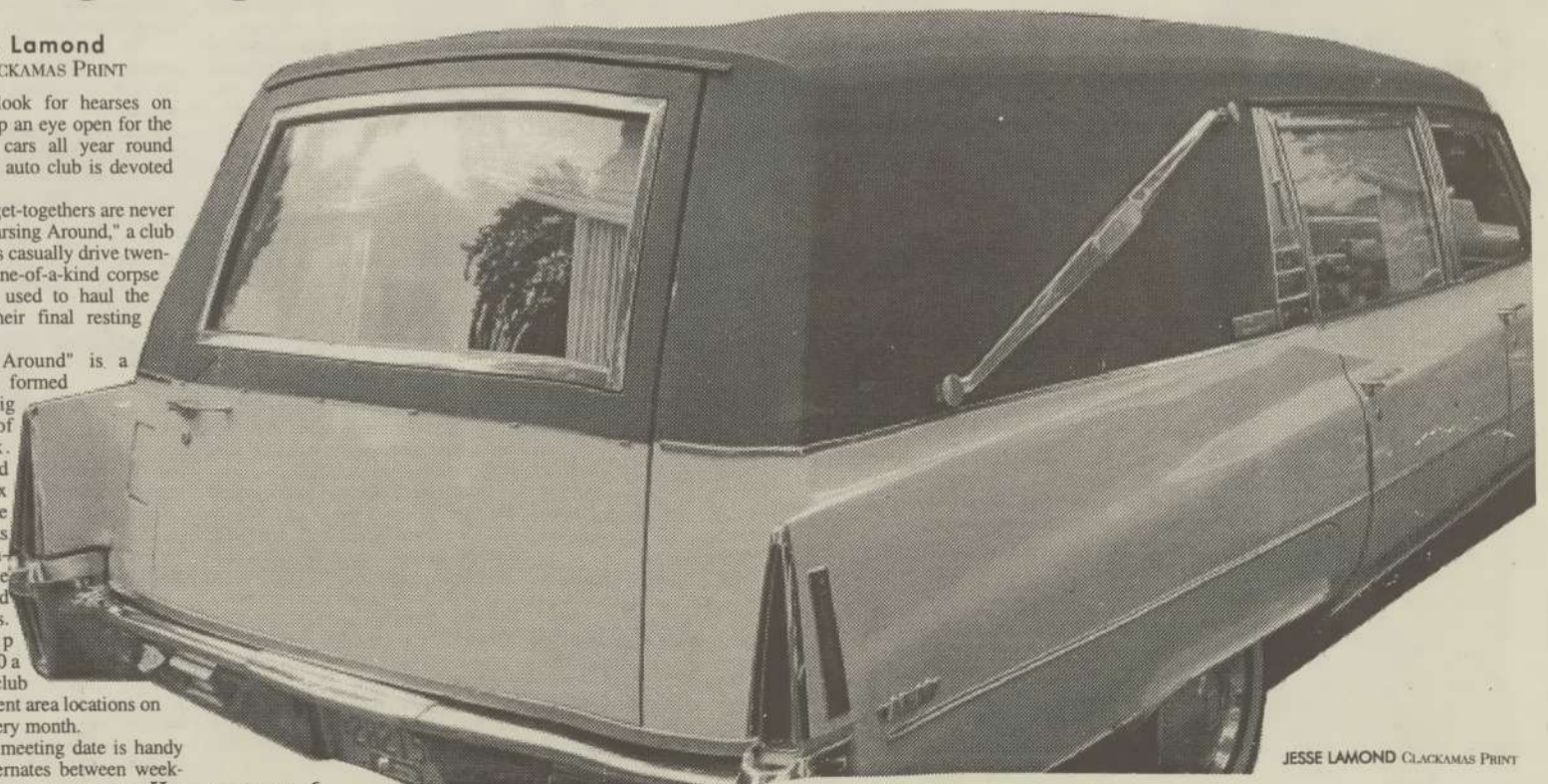
