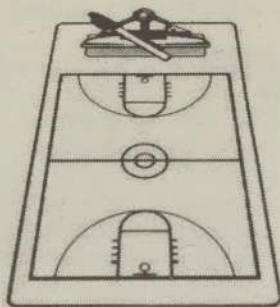

Wrestlers fight back: Five will go to nationals

In what Coach Mike Haluska calls "their best performance all year," five Clackamas wrestlers plowed their way through the regional tournament last weekend and will compete in the national championships, Feb. 26 in Rochester, Minnesota.

Shane Slover (141 lbs., fourth place), Jimmy Crisman (149 lbs., fourth place), Nick Stacks (184 lbs., third place), Chaz Cointment (197 lbs., third place) and John Bastings (Heavyweight, fourth place) will be participating in a tournament against the best the NJCAA has to offer, and will have two weeks to prepare.

"They wrestled better than I ever expected," said Haluska. "It was exciting to be able to watch them wrestle that hard."

The wrestlers have been focused on these two tournaments all year long, and after what has seemed to be a less-than-ideal season, Haluska knows there's still work to do before they're finished.

"I've always wanted people to train for regionals and nationals," Haluska said, admitting that the team may not have showed much in their regular season duals because their focus all season has been these tournaments.

Another wrestler who performed well at regionals over the weekend was Tim Cook, who injured his shoulder early in the season. Cook did not make one of the top four slots he needed to head to Minnesota, but did manage to win his final match as a Clackamas wrestler.

The wrestlers will be training until Tuesday, Feb. 22, and will leave the following day for Rochester and the NJCAA National Tournament.
