Standard Advertising Rates

- **Open rate:** \$6.25 per column inch.
- **Contract rate:** Three contracted issues: \$5.50 per column inch, each separate insertion.
- **Term rate:** One full term, consecutive runs, \$4 per column inch, each separate insertion.
- **Non-profit organization and any CCC organization:** (501c3) \$4 per column inch any number of insertions.
- **Classifieds:** \$2 for the first 15 words and 15¢ for every word thereafter. Classifieds are free for CCC students, staff and faculty.
- **Color** is available for \$100 per color. Full color is \$300.

- 2 Column - 3 7/8 inches - 23.35 picas
- 3 Column - 5 7/8 inches - 35.5 picas
- 4 Column - 8 inches - 48 picas

Guidelines
