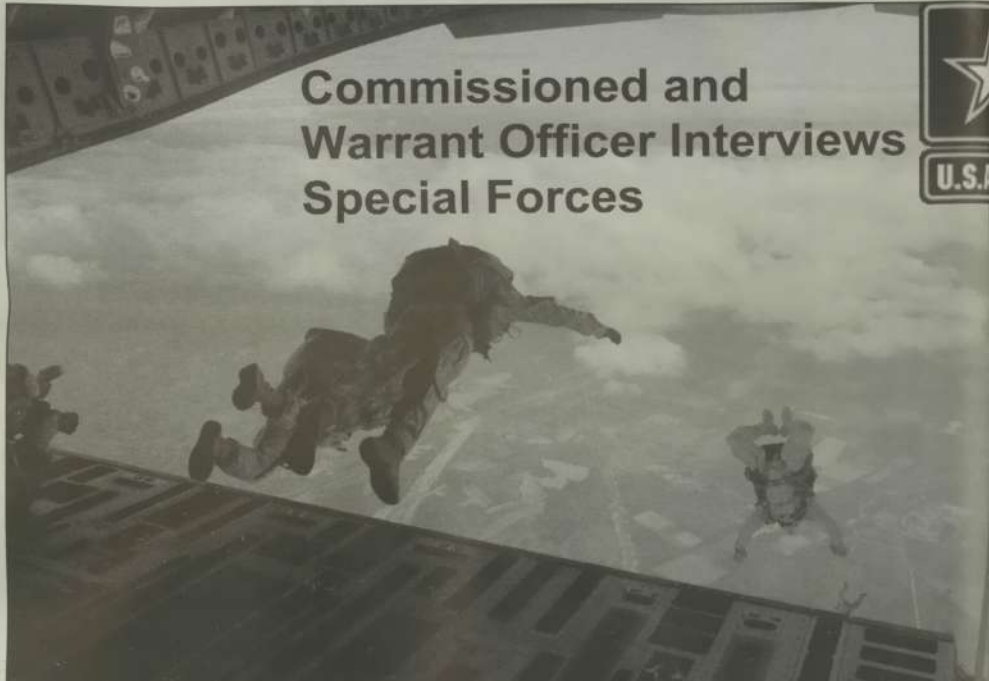
Drag Show
