## Nostalgia at Chinook Winds

It will be a proud and heart-warming look back at the bittersweet sounds of World War II July 1 and 2 as Chinook Winds Casino hosts "A Big Band Salute to America!" Veteran singer Beryl Davis, who performed with the legendary Glenn Miller Orchestra during the war years, will take the stage with Ted Herman and his Orchestra. They will perform those Swing-era sounds we remember so well recalling a time when the nation laughed, cried, and danced amidst joy, sorrow and fevered hope for final victory.

Beryl Davis, daughter of band leader Harry Davis and his lead singer, was discovered in London by Glenn Miller who enlisted her

to sing with his highly acclaimed Army Air Force Orchestra. Over the years she has performed with the Glenn Miller Orchestra, Frank Sinatra, Benny Goodman, Vaughn Monore and David Rose and His Orchestra. Her rendition of "I'll Be Seeing You" has become her vocal trademark and is always dedicated to the memory of Major Glenn Miller, whose tragic death in a plane crash during the war stunned the world.

Ted Herman and His Orchestra are masters at that unique "Big Band" sound that has never really lost its appeal. Today, a whole new generation is discovering its charm.

Having worked with the biggest names in entertainment, including Harry James, Louis Armstrong, Count Basie, Henry Mancini, Nelson Riddle, Sammy Davis, Jr., Frank Sinatra, Barbra Streisand, Elvis, and Liza Minelli, Ted brings a rare combination of absolute professionalism and an infectious passion for the music to every performance.

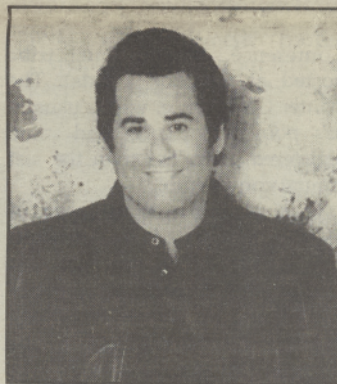

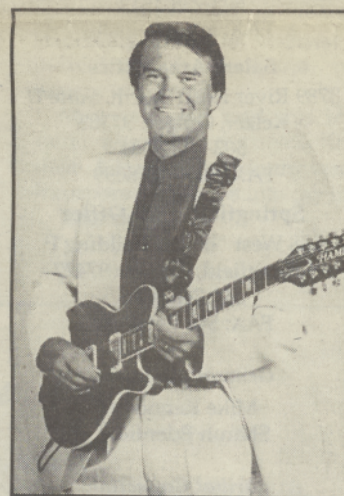
