MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Candidate must hold a Master's degree in one of the behavioral or social sciences and be a registered or certified therapist, eligible to receive and conduct third party billing. Applicants may be considered if they can obtain their license/certification within 18 months of the hire date, and are eligible to receive third party billing through the case supervisor. Must have a demonstrated experience in working with high risk populations conducting individual and group therapy, and adept in child therapy practices. Therapy focus must also demonstrate eclectic skill in crisis counseling, family dynamics, sexual abuse, child development, behavior modification, domestic violence, deficit disorder, post-traumatic stress, fetal alcohol syndrome/effect, goal development, parenting, and communication disorders. The applicant must possess cultural competency and significant knowledge of the Indian Child Welfare Act, and Tribal Sovereignty issues. Must be able to conduct monthly group video discussions focusing on therapy modalities and group discussion topics. Must be willing to travel and coordinate a flexible schedule. Must be able to work cooperatively with other Tribal professionals, and state and tribal court systems. The applicant must communicate effectively in both written and verbal exchanges of information. Must have a valid Oregon state drivers license, good driving record, and reliable transportation. Must be able to pass a mandatory drug screening and criminal background check. Abstinence from drugs and alcohol during employment is required.
