

Lincoln City Antique Week Celebration

The "Antique Week - Lincoln Days 2000" celebration will be held Feb. 11 to 21. Abraham Lincoln exhibits will be on display at the North Lincoln County Historical Museum, cinema history and silent movies will play at the 60-year-old Bijou Theatre, and a taste of pioneer history will be found at the Coastal Community Cultural Center during the Pioneer Cemetery Talk.

On Feb. 12, an old-time social gathering will take place at the Taft High School commons, with a Redhead Round-up tribute, the Siletz Tribal dancers, and a beard contest showing the best "old growth" and "new growth" beards.

The Factory Stores @ Lincoln City are "Thinkin' Lincoln" with the largest sidewalk sale of the year. The stores will compete in a cash collection for the American Red Cross on Feb. 18-21.
