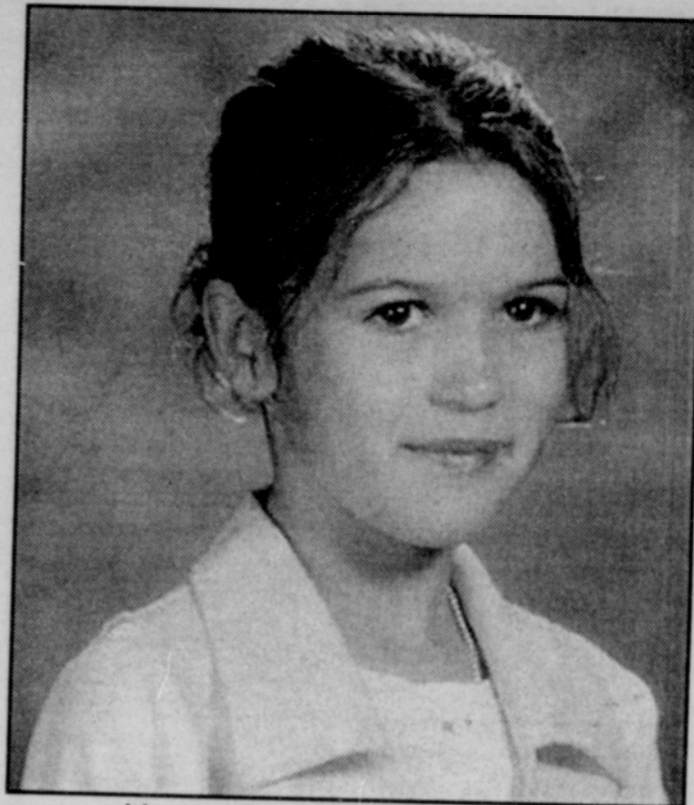

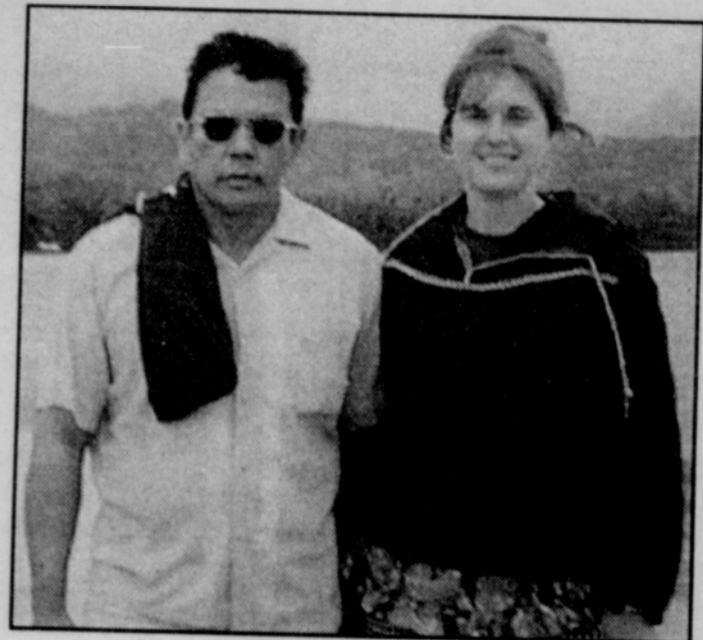

23rd Psalm

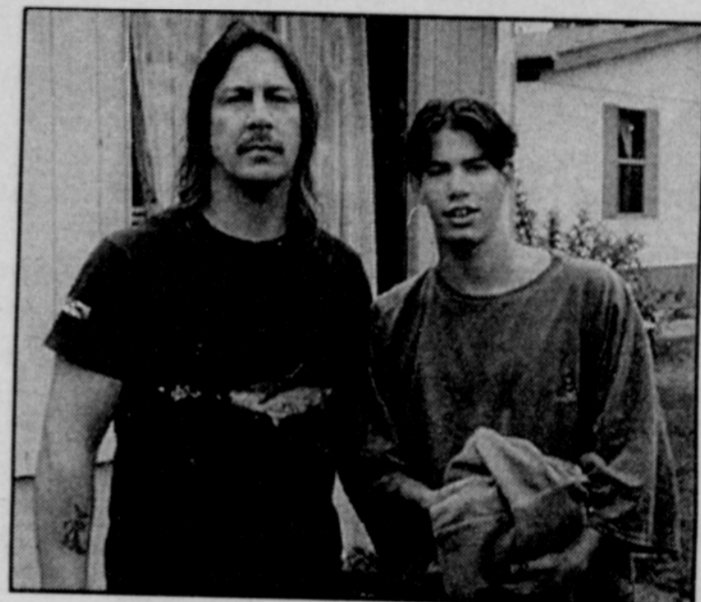
