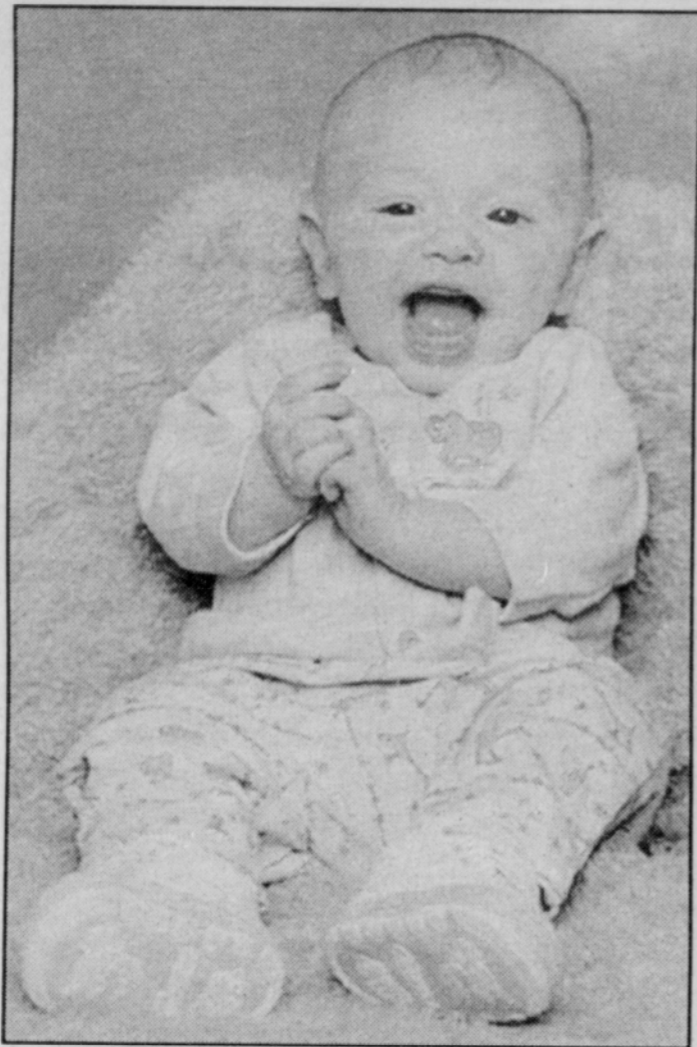


PASSAGES

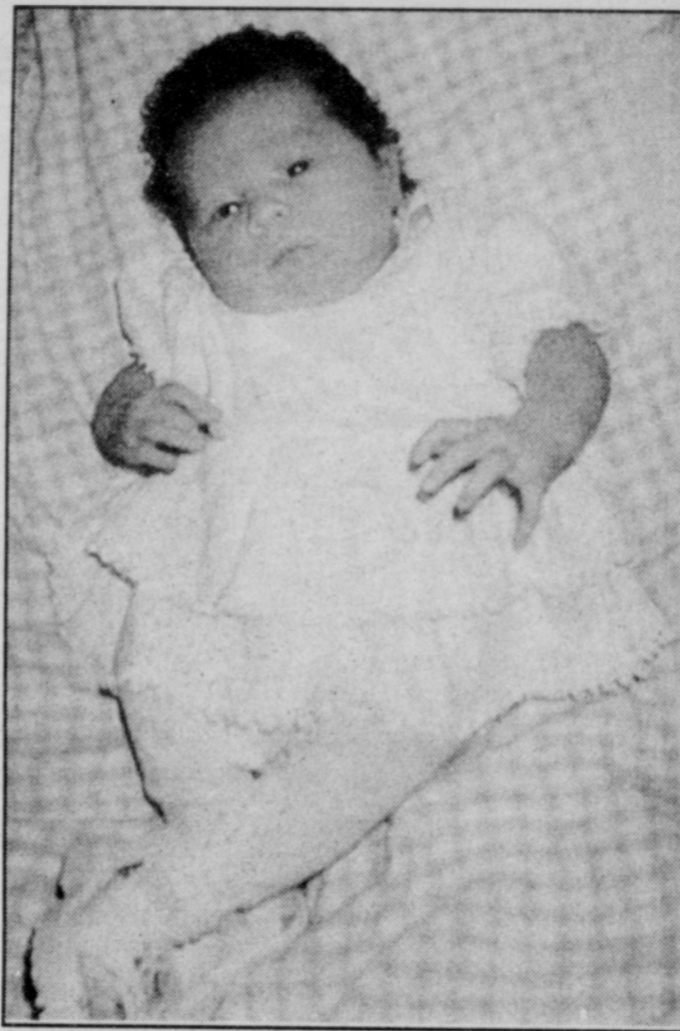

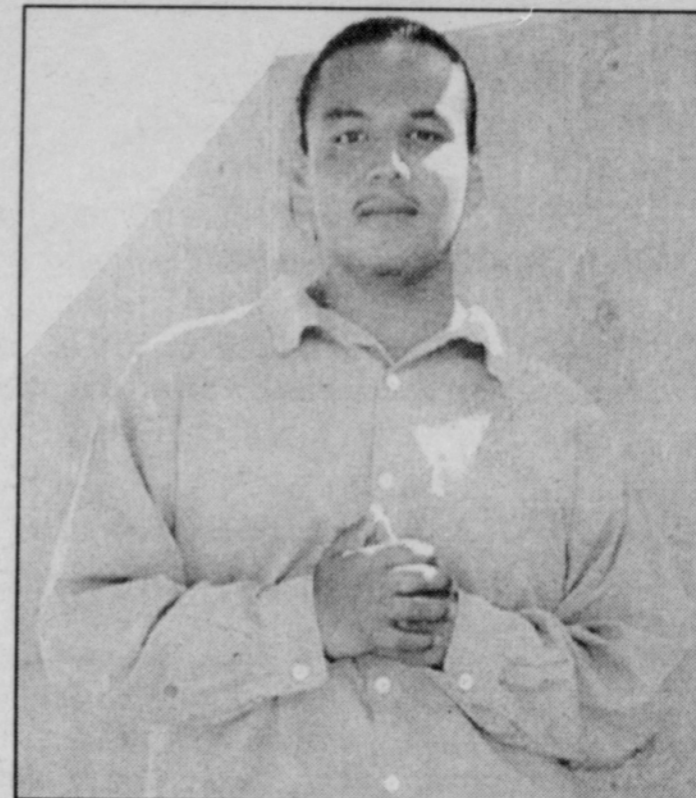
