## The Long and Short of It

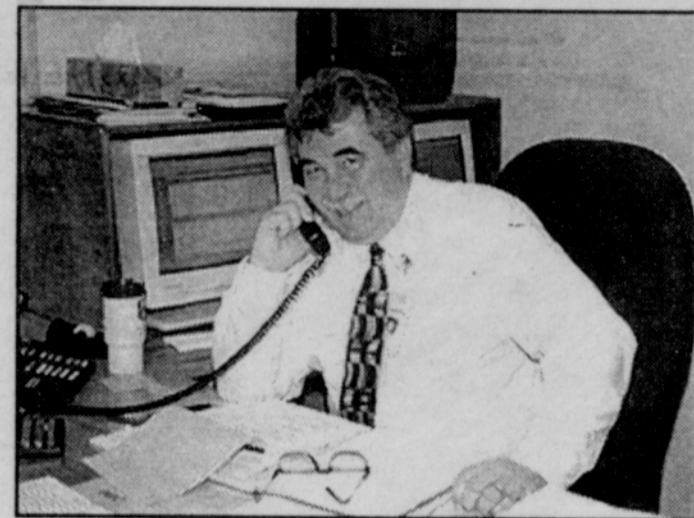
There's a lot of stuff going on here at
