Blackjack Dealers, Wage: A2.0/A2.4 - \$6.50/7.48 – 6 months experience dealing in a casino environment preferred. Strong interpersonal skills to achieve customer service standards. Demonstrated ability in basic mathematical calculation. Dexterity and motor skills to handle chips and cards.

Multi-Games Dealer, Wage: A2.0/A2.4 - \$6.50/7.48 – Same as Blackjack dealer. Also deals Craps or Roulette; must deal a minimum of two games.

Utility Worker, Wage: A4.0/A4.4 - \$8.16/9.38 – Experience providing cleaning, janitorial, and housekeeping services. Ability to lift 50 lbs. routinely. Previous experience operating commercial cleaning equipment preferred. Moving furniture and equipment as required. Must have excellent customer service skills.

Keno Writer/Runner, Wage: A4.0/A4.4 - \$8.16/9.38 – High-volume money handling skills. Previous experience in customer service and public contact. Detail oriented and experienced with numbers/money.

Food & Beverage Utility (Buffet Runner, Buffet/Fine Dining Busser), Wage: A3.0/3.4 - \$7.28/8.37 – Previous experience working in a high-volume, fast-paced restaurant/kitchen, dining room atmosphere preferred. Ability to lift 50 lbs. consistently. Knowledge of regulations governing food preparation and service. Ability to obtain food handlers permit; will rotate between several duties within Food & Beverage Department. Minimum age requirement is 16 years.

Prep Cook, Wage A4.0/A4.4 - \$8.16/9.38 – Experience in high-volume food prep. Knowledge of preparation of soups, sauces, stocks, and hot foods. Demonstrated knife skills.

Beverage Server, Wage: A2.0/2.4 - \$6.50/7.48 – Strong interpersonal skills to achieve customer service standards. Previous experience in the food service industry preferred. Ability to acquire and maintain food servers permit and OLCC liquor permit.

Servers Dining Room, Wage: A2.0/2.4 - \$6.50/7.48 – Previous dining room experience. Must have strong interpersonal skills to achieve customer service standards. Ability to obtain and maintain OLCC and food handlers permits.

Buffet Server, Wage: A2.0/A2.4 - \$6.50/7.48 – Ability to work in a fast-paced environment with strong interpersonal skills to achieve customer service standards. Ability to obtain food handlers permit.

Food & Beverage Cashier (Deli Attendant, Buffet & Fine Dining Host/Hostess), Wage: A3.0/A3.4 - \$7.28/8.37 – Strong interpersonal skills to achieve customer service standards. Experience and demonstrated ability in operation of point of sales systems. Ability to obtain a food handlers permit. Takes, prepares, and dispenses food orders in deli, acts as cashier in the buffet.

Heavy Duty Cleaner, Wage: A4.0/A4.4 - \$8.16/9.38 – Ability to lift up to 50 lbs. Ability to provide quality assurance, maintain health code regulations.

All positions require a pre-employment drug screen, a 90-day introductory period, and the ability to acquire a Siletz Tribal Gaming License, which includes a background investigation. The tribe's Indian Preference Policy will apply with tribal certification. After the Indian Preference Policy has been met, Chinook Winds also will show preference in employment and promotion to current employees who meet the minimum qualifications of the position.
