

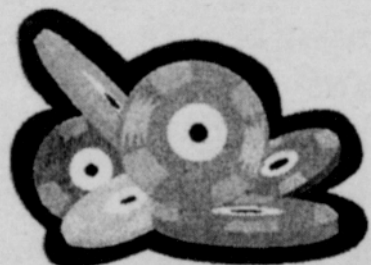

All-Sports Trade Show Returns

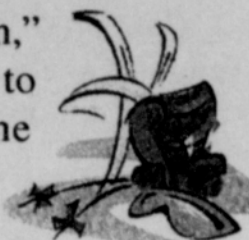
