Siletz Tribe Donates \$63,990 to Community

The Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution Fund made another round of distributions on May 2 at Chinook Winds Casino & Convention Center.

Twenty-five organizations shared \$63,990.95 in contributions. The seven-member advisory board will distribute a total of \$349,000 by the end of 2002.

Eligibility for funds is limited to two categories:

- Entities and activities located in the Siletz Tribe's 11-county service area (Lincoln, Tillamook, Linn, Lane, Benton, Polk, Yamhill, Marion, Multnomah, Washington, and Clackamas counties)
- Native American entities and activities located anywhere in the United States
