The undisputed "King of Romance," the crooner to top all crooners, Engelbert Humperdinck will perform at Chinook Winds Casino on Sept. 6 and 7.

Although he has changed with the times to a more contemporary mode, the voice of this man with the 3-rd octave vocal range is more powerful and richer than ever.
