Recipients of the latest grants from the Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution Fund

## Siletz Tribe Donates \$69,700 to Community

The Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution Fund made another round of distributions on Nov. 8 at Chinook Winds Casino & Convention Center.

Thirty-six organizations shared \$69,700.41 in contributions. The seven-member advisory board has distributed a total of \$349,000 since its inception in 2001.

Eligibility for funds is limited to two categories:

- ≤ Entities and activities located in the Siletz Tribe's 11-county service area (Lincoln, Tillamook, Linn, Lane, Benton, Polk, Yamhill, Marion, Multnomah, Washington, and Clackamas counties)
- ≤ Native American entities and activities located anywhere in the United States

Prior to establishing the Advisory Board in 2001, the Siletz Tribe distributed a percentage of gaming revenues through an ad-hoc committee that awarded \$134,020 to various organizations throughout Oregon.
