Battle at the Beach Packs Them In

More than 700 people attended the Battle at the Beach hosted by Chinook Winds Casino in November.

The Battle at the Beach, Olympic-style amateur boxing, was sanctioned by USA Boxing, the official amateur boxing association. Youth boxers, including some Olympic hopefuls, age 12 and up were featured in this boxing contest.

Nine bouts, including one girls' match, consisted of three or four rounds of one or two minutes each, depending on the classification. Venues such as this help establish youth boxing records for consideration as Olympic contenders.

The Siletz Tribal Honor Guard opened the proceedings, with Siletz Tribal member Apples Lane singing *The Star Spangled Banner*. Roger Robertson, local radio personality, was the ring announcer.

Local talent Robert "Bo" Marthaller was the winner of the most exciting bout of the evening. Bo is originally from Siletz, graduated from Toledo High School in 1996, and is an OSU graduate.
