

Casino Chip Show Returns

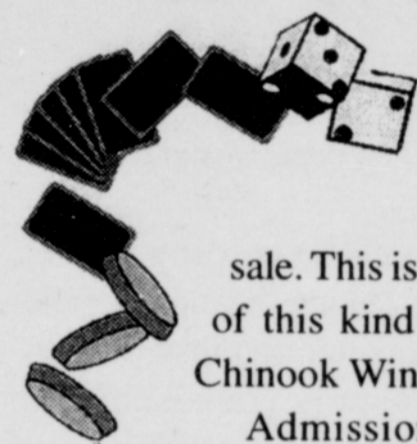

- Each guest receives \$1,000 in tournament chips. We play 15 hands; the two players with the most money in chips will move on to a semi-final round.
- We offer one re-buy round played after the semi-final round.
- The final table has seven finalists. First-, second-, and third-place winners receive value chips and the other four receive dinner for two in the buffet.
- If you are first, second, or third in any one of the tournaments, you then qualify for the Tournament of Champions on June 14, 2003, and the Grand Tournament of Champions on Dec. 13, 2003.
- The Tournament of Champions is a free \$2,500 tournament with an hors d'oeuvres party. The Grand Tournament of Champions is a free \$10,000 tournament with a banquet before play.
