The 2003 Nesika Illahee Pow-Wow Parade is gearing up for the Aug. 9 event. Long-time Tribal Council member Mary A. "Dolly" Fisher will serve as grand marshals for the parade, which will have a patriotic theme.

Last year, more than 30 participants joined in the celebration. Expected in this year's parade are tribal royalty, equestrian units, vintage cars (including the Oregon Coast Corvettes and Bay City Cruisers), dancers, drummers, and entries from tribal staff and local merchants.

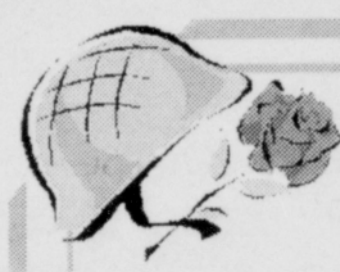
Dance Sponsors Needed

A free shuttle will be available from various parking lots in Siletz to the Pauline Ricks Memorial Pow-Wow Grounds on Government Hill, where the pow-wow action takes place. Parking is extremely limited at the pow-wow grounds, which makes the shuttle the best way to get there. A variety of food and Native arts and crafts and jewelry will be offered for sale by about 50 vendors surrounding the pow-wow arena.
