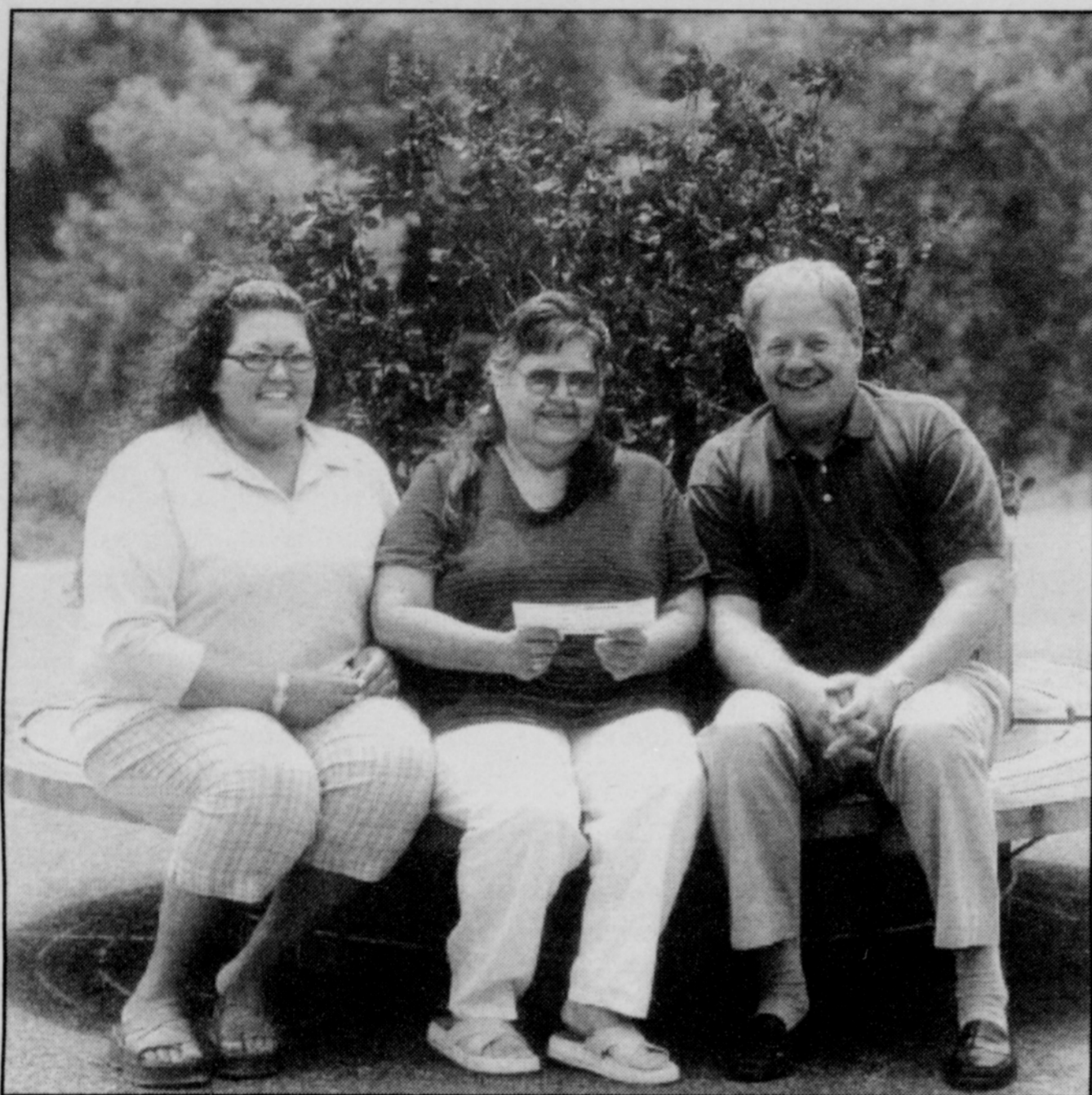

Highway 101 and take part for as long as they can. People can join us in the evening and participate in the relay for as long as possible before returning home. Those who help in this way are very much appreciated by runners who continue through the night.

- People unable to run may volunteer for the support team. It sets up base camp each afternoon. Base camp is a place where relay runners/walkers can eat, shower, and rest until their next shift on the run.
- Supporters/participants can run or walk to represent a tribal elder or tribal member who isn't able to run or walk.

An **orientation meeting** is scheduled for Sept. 17 at 6:30 p.m. at the Tribal Community Center in Siletz. The run begins on Sept. 18 at 8:30 a.m. at the Siletz Tribal Community Center and ends on Sept. 20 near Agness, Ore.

For those who make a commitment to join us, please remember to bring a sleeping bag, towels, good shoes, plenty of socks, and personal care items.

The **campsite** on Sept. 18 will be at Honeyman State Park campground, south of Florence, Ore., and on Sept. 19 at the group area in Humbug State Park, near Humbug Mountain, south of Port Orford, Ore. Maps will be provided.
