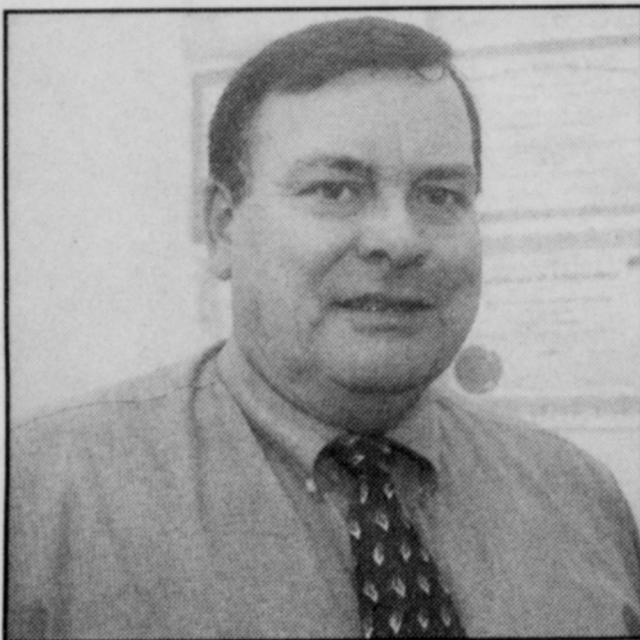


## Pounders Hired as Facilities Manager
