

Lorange Named Third Quarter Superstar

Dixie Lorange from the Security Department, who also is an EMT, was selected as the casino's Superstar for the third quarter of 2003.

Tribal elders, members of the Gaming Council, the Siletz Tribal Gaming Regulatory Agency, Chinook Winds directors, and several casino staff members were present at the Superstar ceremony on Oct. 30. Instances of exemplary performance must be documented.

After a person is nominated for the award, the nomination goes through several reviews before the final selection is made. Both casino staff and casino guests can submit Superstar nominations. With more than 700 employees and only four of these awards given each year, it's a real honor to be chosen as the Superstar.


which are requesting stocking stuffers for their Christmas baskets.
