

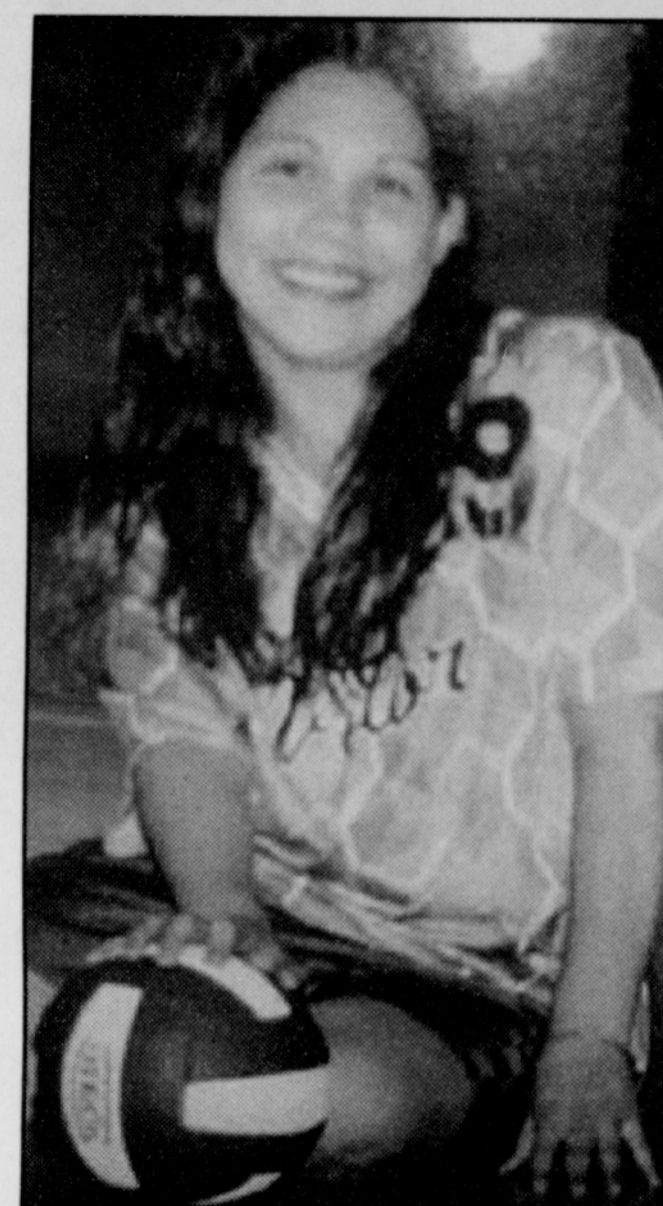
# PASSAGES
