## Scholarships Available; Deadlines Near

### National Institutes of Health

The National Institutes of Health Undergraduate Scholarship Program has 15 scholarships of up to \$20,000 per academic year for tuition, educational expenses, and reasonable living expenses for scholarship recipients. Scholarships are awarded for one year and can be renewed up to four years.

This program offers competitive scholarships to students from disadvantaged backgrounds who are committed to careers in biomedical, behavioral, and social science health-related research. The program offers:

- Scholarship support
- Paid research training at the NIH during the summer
- Paid employment and training at the NIH after graduation

### Morris K. Udall Foundation

The Morris K. Udall Foundation has 80 \$5,000 scholarships available for sophomore and junior undergraduate students in two categories:
